

Man stabbed to death for protesting lewd remarks on daughter

New Delhi

A 51-year-old businessman was stabbed to death allegedly for objecting to lewd comments made by some boys on his daughter in West Delhi's Moti Nagar area, police said Monday.

The man's 19-year-old son was also injured in the incident that took place in the early hours of Sunday, they said.

The boys passed some lewd comments and made indecent gestures at the businessman's 24-year-old daughter, when they were returning home on a two-wheeler from a hospital, police said.

The man had taken his daughter to hospital after she complained of severe headache.

The man after dropping his daughter home, complained to the boys' father about their behaviour, claimed a family member, who did not want to be named.

An argument broke out over the issue and in the

midst of it, the businessman was attacked and stabbed multiple times, he alleged.

Hearing the commotion, some people came out of their houses, but no one intervened, the family member said.

The victim's 19-year-old son came to his father's rescue, but he was also stabbed.

Somewhat, he managed to raise an alarm after which his mother and sister rushed to the spot and took the father-son duo to a hospital.

The businessman succumbed to injuries Monday morning, while his son is still battling for life, police said.

Confirming the incident, Deputy Commissioner of Police (West) Monika Bhardwaj said a case was registered and an investigation initiated.

Two men -- a 20-year-old man and his 45-year-old father -- have been arrested.

Two sons of the accused, who are juveniles, have also been apprehended in connection with the incident.

EVMs safe under 3-tier vigil: Haryana ADGP Virk

Haryana Additional Director General of Police (Law and Order), Mr Navdeep Singh Virk said that a foolproof three-tier security arrangement backed by CCTV cameras has been put in place for all EVMs and VVPAT machines used in polling after peaceful conduct of General Parliamentary Election across the state.

Virk said that EVMs and VVPAT machines brought to the designated strong rooms from all polling stations where Police and paramilitary personnel will guard the rooms under round the clock vigil.

Detailing about the three-tier arrangements, he said that in the first layer, Central Armed Police Forces are deployed near the strong rooms, Haryana Armed Police personnel posted in second layer and district police personnel are manning the

outer layer. He said that 90 strong rooms have been established at 38 locations with 24x7 tight security and CCTV surveillance to ensure the safety of EVMs and VVPAT machines.

It may be mentioned here that EVMs kept in strong rooms in the state will be opened on May 23 for counting.

Virk said that Haryana Police throughout the election season kept the information flowing about police deployment or recoveries. The idea was to reassure the citizens of its presence and create a fear in the minds of those planning any disruption, he added.

He also commended the all officers and jawans of State Police and other security forces who had worked tirelessly for ensuring free, fair and peaceful election across the state.

Yadava has also appreciated all ranks of State Police and other security forces who ac-

tively participated in peaceful conduct of Lok Sabha polls in the State.

In a message issued here today, Mr Yadava said that general elections in Haryana were conducted in a smooth, peaceful and incident-free manner due to their hard work, dedication, sincerity and energetic patrolling since early morning.

3 arrested with Rs 2.5 Cr of stolen mobile phone

Three persons have been arrested by the Kasna police along with 1240 mobile phones worth Rs 2.5 crore

70.31 pc voter turnout in Haryana, compilation of figures still on

Chandigarh

Over 70 per cent of Haryana's 1.80 crore electorate exercised their franchise in the polling for 10 Lok Sabha seats in the state on Sunday according to the data compiled till Monday morning, officials said.

The highest polling percentage was recorded in Sirsa parliamentary constituency (75.97 per cent), followed by Kurukshetra (74.36 per cent) and Hisar (72.16 per cent), while Faridabad (64.34 per cent) and Karnal (68.54 per cent) recorded comparatively less voter turnout.

"We are still in the process of compiling of figures. As per data available till Monday

morning, the poll percentage recorded in Haryana was 70.31 per cent. However, this is likely to rise slightly when all the data is compiled," Haryana's Joint Chief Electoral Officer, Inder Jeet said on Monday.

In the 2014 general elections, the overall polling percentage was at 71.86, while in 1977, the voter turnout was 73.26 per cent. However, in 1999, 2004 and 2009 Lok Sabha polls, the turnout was under 70 per cent.

As many as 223 candidates, including two Union ministers and a former chief minister, are in the fray for the 10 seats in Haryana. Of the total candidates 11 are



women. Prominent candidates in fray included Union minis-

ters Rao Inderjit Singh (Gurgaon) and Krishan Pal Gurjar (Faridabad) of the BJP, for-

Man held for supplying illegal arms to gangsters in Delhi, Haryana

New Delhi

A 26-year-old man has been arrested for allegedly supplying illegal fire arms to gangsters in Delhi and Haryana, police said Monday.

The accused, identified as Sumit Kharab, a resident of Mundhela Khurd village near Jaffarpur area here, was nabbed on Sunday, the day Delhi went to polls, they said.

Following a tip-off that an illegal arms supplier would come near a nursery plantation opposite a mall in Dwarka with a huge cache of illegal arms, the arrest was made, Deputy Commissioner of Police (Dwarka) Anto Alphonse said.

Four sophisticated pistols and a country-made gun with



two cartridges were seized from the accused, he said.

Interrogation revealed that in 2014 the accused was arrested in Bahadurgarh area of Haryana where he came in contact with several gangs based in Haryana and Delhi, he said.

After assessing the need

for illegal fire arms and the profit attached to it, Kharab began his illegal trade, the DCP said.

In 2017, he was arrested for possessing a fire arm in Dwarka and was sent to Tihar Jail.

There, he came in contact with another inmate Aarush of Khurja in Uttar Pradesh who was undergoing judicial custody for the offence of possessing illegal fire arm.

The two planned the procurement of illegal weapons for sale in Delhi and adjoining areas, the officer said.

After the death of his father, Kharab left studies and started farming on his land, police said, adding that during this time he developed an addiction for alcohol.

Gang forging Aadhaar cards, driving licences busted; 7 held

Noida (UP)

With the arrest of seven persons, the Noida Police Monday claimed to have busted a gang that made fake documents like Aadhaar cards, driving licenses and college mark sheets.

The fraud came to light on Sunday when Pawan Kumar Verma, who runs a private company, approached the police claiming that one of his employees had got the job in his firm using forged documents, the police said.

A case was registered at the Phase 3 Police Station and probe taken up, an officer said.

"Preliminary inquiry led

the investigators to the gang operating from a park in Sector 71," the official said.

"Seven men were arrested. Five forged academic mark sheets, six fake Aadhaar cards, five fake certificates along with electronic equipment were seized from the spot," the officer said.

Jogendra Kumar, Saurabh Kumar, Pradeep Kumar, Srinivas, Manveer, Ravindra Kumar and Sadaqat were arrested and booked under Indian Penal Code sections for fraud and forgery of documents, the officer added. They have been remanded to judicial custody, he said further.

Then the onlookers intervened and rescued the woman. The woman has filed a police complaint. The police are investigating the case.

The police have registered the case and a search is on to hunt for the offenders who are on the run. The incident is of the Knowledge Park Police station of Kaushalya residency.

5-yr-old girl found murdered in Haryana

A five-year-old girl was found murdered in a vacant plot in Haryana's Panchkula district on Monday, with police suspecting that she might have been raped before being killed, a senior police official said.

The parents of the girl lodged a complaint with the police that their daughter had gone missing from her home on Monday. Later, her body was found lying in a vacant plot near a private school, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Panchkula, Nupur Bishnoi said.

"Investigations into the case are on. We are not ruling out sexual assault in the case. Prima facie, it appears that she was raped," she said.

Woman thrashed publicly by employer, aides over salary

Greater Noida

A woman, working at a salon in Greater Noida, was thrashed in public by at least three men, including her employer, over the salary issue.

Police said they have arrested the main accused in the case.

A video of the incident purportedly showing the men beating the woman with sticks and manhandling her publicly also surfaced on social media. Some passers-by were seen filming the attack but no one came to the rescue of the woman.

The goons, also her employer, got angry by this genuine demand from her side and started beating her.

According to information received from the police, these pictures are from Knowledge Park 2 of Greater

Noida.

The feud started after a transaction at a salon between its owner and a female employee and crossed limits of decency.

According to the complaint of the woman, even before the thrashing began, she had undergone unmitigated torture in the hands of her employer.

The woman has alleged that she was employed by the salon as a make-up artiste on 16 March on a salary of Rs 17,000 per month. On completion of one month, when the victim asked for her salary, the male employer began to coerce her to get physical with him. Indeed, two of her male colleagues demanded sexual favours from the woman.
