

Delhi records over 4K new COVID-19 cases, highest single-day spike so far

238 fresh COVID cases in GB Nagar

As many as 238 new Coronavirus positive cases were reported in the Gautam Buddh Nagar district during the past 24 hours leading the tally of the infected people in the district to 9364 on Wednesday.

At the same 132 patients were discharged from hospital. According to the data released by the state health department on Wednesday, as many as 238 people have been confirmed to have Coronavirus infection in Gautam Buddh Nagar during the last 24 hours.

Whereas 7612 patients have recovered so far in the district, 1696 patients are currently being treated in different hospitals in the district. As many as 48 persons have died due to Coronavirus in the district so far.

The national capital recorded 4,039 fresh COVID-19 cases on Wednesday, the highest single-day spike so far, as the tally breached the two lakh-mark, while the death toll mounted to 4,638, authorities said.

This is the first time since the outbreak of the pandemic that over 4,000 cases have been recorded in Delhi in a day.

The previous highest single-day spike of 3,947 cases was recorded on June 23.

Twenty fatalities have been recorded in the last 24 hours, according to the latest bulletin issued by the Delhi health department.

The tally of active cases rose to 23,773 from 22,377 the previous day, it said.

The death toll from



COVID-19 in Delhi stood at 4,618 on Tuesday.

The bulletin on Wednesday said the death toll from coronavirus infection has

risen to 4,638 and the total number of cases has climbed to 2,01,174.

-Kejriwal directs authorities to take steps

to prevent spread of COVID-19 in Delhi-

Amid a rise in the number of COVID-19 cases, Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Ke-

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The chief minister held a review meeting with Health Minister Satyendar Jain, Chief Secretary Vijay Dev, senior officials and medical superintendents of Delhi government-run hospitals.

"Had a review meeting with Health Minister, Chief Secretary, senior officials and MS of govt hospitals. I

have directed all MS and authorities to take all possible steps to prevent the spread of Corona and assured the hospitals of full support in this regard," Kejriwal said in a tweet.

On Tuesday, the national capital recorded 3,609 fresh cases, the highest single-day spike in 76 days, as a record over 45,000 COVID-19 tests were conducted in the city.

The single-day casecount on Tuesday was the highest since June 25, when the city

had recorded 3,390 cases. On June 23, Delhi had recorded the highest single-day spike of 3,947 cases so far.

The figure on Tuesday also surpassed Sunday's figure when the national capital had recorded 3,256 cases.

In an interview to a news agency, Jain had said that the sharp spike in COVID-19 cases in the national capital will "plateau" after ten days or so.

"One of the main reasons why we are seeing such a rise in the number of fresh cases is because we are going aggressive as far as testing is concerned. We have been conducting tests in markets, crowded places, mohalla clinics, hospitals, and many other places," Jain had said.

Delhi police to deploy dedicated team to prosecute COVID norms violators

Delhi Police on Wednesday said each of its police stations will deploy a dedicated team which will be sent to one location in their respective district to prosecute those violating Covid-19 norms.

The decision was taken after the national capital experiencing a fresh surge in its daily coronavirus cases, police said.

Earlier, Delhi Traffic police was entrusted with the responsibility of issuing challans for violations of coronavirus-related regulations.

"In view of spread of coronavirus in Delhi, each police station shall detail one dedicated team, comprising of an upper subordinate and one lower subordinate to report to one location in their respec-

tive district to prosecute persons who violate protocols", the Delhi Police said Wednesday in a statement.

This statement by the Delhi Police comes even as a number of economic activities have opened up in the national capital as a part of the ongoing fourth stage of the nationwide unlock. While Metro services resumed on Monday, schools, too, will partially reopen from 21 September.

With road traffic returning to "near normal" in the city, the traffic police has been asked to focus on managing vehicular movement, withdrawing them from COVID-19-related tasks such as issuing fines for spitting in public places, not wearing mask and violating distancing norms.

Executives of Noble Co-operative Bank beaten-up, threatened for life; NCR filed

Four executives of Noble Co-operative Bank were allegedly thrashed, beaten-up and threatened for life by loan defaulters and family members inside Jagriti Apartment, Noida Sector-71.

The bank officials had gone to paste auction notices against Mortgage property under the provisions of SARFAESI Act 2002.

The incident was allegedly reported last week on Tuesday, August 25.

An NCR (Non-Cognizable Report) was registered against the accused Udayveer Yadav and at his flat no 93A, Block A-3 Jagriti Apartment, Sector-71 to paste auction notice, the NCR reads.

As the bank officials reached at Udayveer Yadav's flat to compile legal procedure, he along with family

plainant Mehar Singh, Pradeep Sharma, Sagar and Arun work as executives for Noble Co-operative Bank situated at Noida Sector-22.

On August 25, they had visited the residence of loan defaulter namely Udayveer Yadav and at his flat no 93A, Block A-3 Jagriti Apartment, Sector-71 to paste auction notice, the NCR reads.

As the bank officials reached at Udayveer Yadav's flat to compile legal procedure, he along with family

members namely Satpal Yadav, Mahesh Yadav and Rahul Yadav rushed at the spot and allegedly started abusing and beating them. They started threatening to kill them with asking his associates to bring revolver from car to shoot them, the NCR further reads.

They (victims) however managed to escape out from the society premises, according to NCR.

A police team 'meanwhile' reached the spot on a PCR call and took the victims to Noida Phase-III police station.

The bank officials however urged SHO Amit Kumar to protect them and lodged a complaint on the basis of which an NCR was registered against the four accused who had beaten up the executives and the investi-

gation was taken-up.

On September, 5, the investigating officer of this case Sub-inspector Shivraj Singh submitted its challan report to Assistant Commissioner of Police I/ City Magistrate, (Central Noida), seeking heavy bail bonds against the accused.

The report reads that during investigation the facts in the NCR filed by complaint is found true.

The report brought notice before the magistrate that the act committed by the accused in the above case is condemnable and criminal by nature. And it can't be refused that such acts couldn't be repeated again in future.

The policemen 'meanwhile' have passed the bank's auction notice on the accused's property in the presence of eyewitnesses.
