

Farmers' protest: FIR lodged against 'creators of toolkit', no one named

Delhi Police has lodged an FIR in connection with 'toolkit' containing information on how to back the farmers' protests. No names have been mentioned in the FIR, a Delhi police officer said.

The 'toolkit' has been doing the rounds on social media and the document was allegedly tweeted by, among others Swedish teen climate change activist Greta Thunberg. She allegedly deleted that tweet and later reposted an updated version of the toolkit.

Praveer Ranjan, Special Commissioner of Police, Delhi Police, on Thursday evening said, "We haven't named anybody in the FIR, it's only against the creators of toolkit which is a matter of investigation & Delhi Police will be investigating that



case."

"Preliminary enquiry has revealed that the toolkit in question appears to have been created by a pro-Khalistani Organisation 'Poetic Justice Foundation'," the police officer said.

The FIR filed by the Special cell of Delhi Police booked unknown people under IPC section, 124A (sedition), 153 A (Promoting en-

mity between different groups) and 120 B (criminal conspiracy), and alleged that these people had organised the farmers protest and tried to ferment trouble.

The cyber branch of Delhi police will investigate the case.

Taking to Twitter, Greta said, "I still #StandWithFarmers and support their peaceful protest. No amount

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of hate, threats or violations of human rights will ever change that. #Farmers-Protest."

Earlier, this week Greta Thunberg took to Twitter to lend support to farmers in India who are protesting against the three new farm laws. The farmers have been sitting at the Delhi border in protest for several days now.

Delhi police is closely monitoring social media in connection with the farmers' agitation. Delhi police has identified 300 social media

handles who are promoting social enmity and malicious content in the name of farmers protest, Mr Ranjan said. In the process of monitoring of social media, one document titled toolkit was uploaded through one of the handles on a particular social media platform, the police officer said.

A preliminary enquiry has revealed that the toolkit appears to have been created by an allegedly pro-Khalistani Organisation Poetic Justice Foundation, Mr Ranjan added.

BJP slams AAP govt over withdrawal of DTC buses hired for police personnel

Delhi BJP leaders on Thursday have strongly condemned the decision of the Delhi government to withdraw the bus service of Delhi Transport Corporation that was provided for Delhi Police and paramilitary forces.

Delhi chief minister Arvind Kejriwal wants to burn Delhi by withdrawing the bus services for Delhi police, the party alleged.

The party, led by leader of the Opposition in Delhi Assembly Ramvir Singh Bidhuri has passed a resolution



on Tuesday demanding that the Delhi government must withdraw its decision and immediately restore the bus service for security forces.

BJP MLAs said that DTC

does not provide its buses free of cost to Delhi Police and other security forces, it charges for it, the security forces use these buses to restore law and order in the na-

tional capital, the resolution said. The situation is tense in Delhi today, there is a possibility of disturbances during the strike on 6 February called by the farmers' leaders. In such a situation, how the police personnel will move from one place to another, Bidhuri asked in the resolution.

BJP legislators from Delhi strongly condemned the violence in Delhi on the occasion of Republic Day and the incident of insulting the tricolor on the Red Fort.

Finalize HIMS project by middle of this year, CM directs officials

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal, while reviewing the ambitious Health Information Management System (HIMS) project on Thursday, directed officials to ensure that the project get finalized by the middle of this year.

Under HIMS, various features such as a web portal, mobile app, etc will be launched to store a database of the health information of the residents of Delhi. The Health Information Management System will be implemented by August 2021 in all the Delhi government hospitals.

CM Kejriwal along with Health and Family Welfare Minister Satyendar Jain and other health departmental officials discussed the progress of the HIMS project, e-health card, and health helpline. Apprising the CM regarding the progress of the project, the departmental officials said that the work is being done as per schedule.

Kejriwal directed the officials to ensure that the work is completed within the stipulated deadline. He also instructed to ensure that the distribution of the health cards is started at the earliest.

In the meeting, the healthcare helpline was also discussed.

Jain also expressed satisfaction over the speed of the work by the health de-

partment on HIMS, e-health card, and health helpline and instructed the department to complete the same within the stipulated time frame.

The health officials gave a presentation for the implementation of HIMS and issuing of the e-health cards. The system seeks to target the healthcare delivery process. All the patient care services, hospital administration, budgeting and planning, supply chain management, and backend services and processes will be brought under the system.

The entire system will be on the cloud and digitized. This will enable the citizens to avail themselves information on one platform, which will help them in emergency cases. With

this, Delhi will become the only state to have a cloud-based health management system. This facility will also be extended to private hospitals in the future.
