Police seize property worth Rs 35 lakh under Gangsters Act

Muzaffarnagar: Police on Friday seized property worth Rs 35 lakh and two vehicles belonging to a gangster in Ghatayan village here, officials said.

According to District Magistrate Chandra Bhushan Singh, history-sheeter Rakesh is involved in at least three dozen cases of murder, loot and illegal liquor trading.

He was booked under the Gangsters Act by the police, the officials said.

Bike stunt turns fatal in Kota, 2 killed, 1 injured

Kota: Two people were killed and a third got critically injured here in the district, when the bike they were riding went out of control and crashed against divider, police said on Friday.

The incident took place Thursday evening when the three friends riding a Bullet Enfield met with an accident while coming down on DCM flyover, allegedly while performing bike stunts, they said. The two deceased were identified as Chandan Rathore (26) of DCM area and Shiva Kumawat (30) of Prem Nagar area, while the injured was identified as Rahul Panchal of Govind Nagar, police said.

The bodies of the two deceased were handed over to their family members after postmortem on Friday morning, and the injured is still unconscious and undergoing treatment.

According to Udhog Nagar police station SHO Manoj Singh Sikarwal, Shiva was driving the motorcycle while his two friends, Chandan and Rahul, were riding pillion when the bike crashed against divider.

6-yr-old girl raped by relative: Police

Budaun: A six-year-old girl was allegedly raped by her relative in a village under Ujhani police station area of the district here, police said on Friday.

The accused has been arrested, police said.

The victim was playing outside her house on Thursday evening when the accused, aged 22, took her away to a nearby forest and allegedly raped her, police said. On finding the girl missing, the parents searched for the girl and traced her to the forest on being told by villagers that they had seen her going with the accused that side.

The girl was taken to the police station from where she was sent to the district hospital for medical examination.

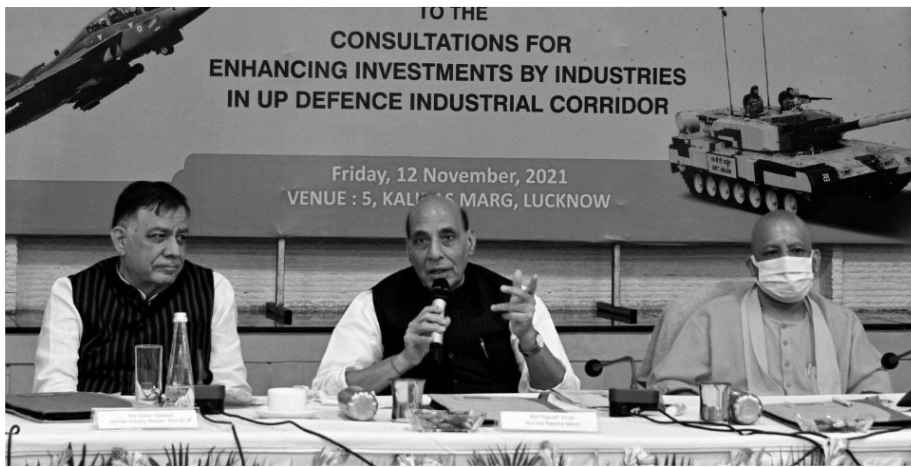

They aim to develop an eco-system for industries that can fulfill all their small and big needs easily from one place and in an economical way, he said.

Stressing that the industrial heritage of Uttar Pradesh is very old, Singh said there are many districts here that are famous for their products the world over.

CM announces Rs. 1.5 lakh each to 36 fire affected families of Malana

He said that fuel wood would also be provided to the affected families. He said that irrigation facilities would also be made available in Jari village under JICA and tapped water would be provided under the Jal Jeevan Mission.

Chief Minister also announced rupees one crore for construction of alternative road to Malana. He directed the PWD authorities to complete the road work within

six months to facilitate the people of the area. He said that this would not only give boost to tourism development in the area but also ensure development of the village. He also urged the people of the area to preserve their rich cultural heritage and also motivate the younger generation to be proud of their culture.

Security forces have arrested an alleged militant from Ganderbal district of Jammu and Kashmir, police said on Friday. The accused was arrested at a police check point erected near Khann in Ganderbal district on Thursday, the police spokesperson said.

The suspect, identified as Arshad Ahmad Mir, was booked under Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, and section 7/25 of the Arms Act as preliminary investigation revealed he was a close associate of terrorist group Lashkar-e-Toiba.

Family members of custodial death victim in Kasganj reject police theory of suicide

Aligarh:

The family members of a 22-year-old man, who died in police custody in this Uttar Pradesh district, has rejected the police theory of suicide and demanded justice and strict punishment for those responsible for his death.

The family has said police are showing a letter purportedly signed by the victim's father, which gives a clean chit to the men in khaki, and alleged that it was obtained under pressure.

Abrar Ahmad, the paternal uncle of Altaf who died in police custody in Kasganj on Tuesday, told reporters here that the letter that carries Altaf's father's thumb impression "has been managed through police pressure".

Speaking to reporters at the Press Club here on Thursday night, Abrar said, "My brother is illiterate and his thumb impression on a piece of paper at a time when he was in a state of shock is meaningless." "My brother is a broken man

and is hardly able to move and that is why I have come to Aligarh to speak on his behalf," he added.

Replying to a question, Abrar said the Kasganj police has given a sum of Rs 5 lakh to one of the family members but he is not aware as to whom the money was handed over as his brother is in no condition to speak.

"Our main demand is that those guilty are duly punished because this theory that Altaf committed suicide by hanging himself is totally concocted by the police," he said.

Students of the Aligarh Muslim University (AMU) took out a protest march in the campus on Thursday and demanded a judicial probe by a sitting judge of the Allahabad High Court.

While the victim's family has alleged that he was killed by the police personnel on duty, police have said he strangled himself using a string from his jacket hood in the washroom of the lock-up.
