Man found dead in hotel room in Delhi's Mahipalpur

A man from Telangana was found dead in a hotel room in Southwest Delhi's Mahipalpur on Thursday morning, police said.

The deceased, Subramanian Rajesh, aged around 40-45 years, is from Shivampalli in Telangana, they said.

He had checked into the hotel on May 19, the police said.

Deputy Commissioner of Police (Southwest) Manoj C said, "We got a call regarding a man who was staying at a hotel in Mahipalpur since a week and was found unconscious." Rajesh was lying unconscious near the bathroom door of the room and was rushed to a hospital, where he was declared brought dead, the DCP said.

The crime team recovered an empty liquor bottle from the spot, he said.

The body has been sent to the Safdarjung mortuary for a post-mortem examination, the police said.

Relatives of the deceased have been informed, and the body will be handed over to them upon their arrival, they added.

Girl commits suicide in Kohat Enclave

A 19-year-old woman was committed suicide by jumping off from 5th floor of her house in North West's Delhi's Kohat Enclave area on Thursday, said police.

The deceased was identified as 19 years old Riya Gupta, daughter of Rajesh Gupta, a resident of Kohat Enclave, Delhi.

We reviewed a PCR call from Saroj hospital in Delhi's Subhash Place regarding death case of Riya Gupta. She was brought dead at hospital, said a police officer.

Immediately a police team reached at hospital, and collected MLC of the deceased in which alleged history was mentioned as fall from height.

During enquiry, father of the deceased stated that she went to the roof of the house for walking at around 7.30 PM and when she didn't return for around 2 hours, he searched for her and found her lying injured in the street near their house. He took her to hospital where she was declared brought dead.

Preliminary enquiries have revealed that the deceased got injured due to fall from the roof of 5th floor of the house and succumbed to injuries.

No foul play has been found during preliminary inquiry, or suspected by family of the deceased.

Accordingly, proceedings u/s 174 CrPC has been conducted and further enquiries are under process.

Delhi LG inspects CP-Airport stretch, calls for complete aesthetic overhaul

Hours after taking the oath of office on Thursday, Delhi Lieutenant Governor Vinai Kumar Saxena hit the streets and conducted a field visit from posh Connaught Place to the airport area and emphasised on "complete aesthetic overhaul" of the entire stretch, officials said.

The Delhi LG inspected stretches on Sardar Patel Marg, Dhaula Kuan, Mahipalpur, Mehram Nagar and Mandi House roundabout among other places and stressed the need for coordination among different government agencies for infrastructure upgrade and enhancing beauty of the national capital, according to a statement issued by the Raj Niwas.

"The LG directed the officials concerned to take



necessary action towards ensuring symmetry in city infrastructure, including roads, footpaths, street lights and signage. He emphasised on ensuring all round cleanliness, timely desilting of drains, greening of roadsides and maintenance of the central verges," the statement read.

After being sworn in as the Lieutenant Governor,

Saxena said, "I want to tell each citizen of Delhi that I will work in the capacity of a local guardian rather than as LG. You will see me less in Raj Niwas and more on the roads." He stressed upon the need "to build Delhi as a global city" with effective cooperation of government and civil society.

The LG instructed officials to come up with a "con-

crete and comprehensive plan of action with fixed timelines" through coordination among different department and agencies.

"During the inspection, the LG emphasised on a complete aesthetic overhaul of the entire stretch from Connaught Place to the airport," a senior official said.

Saxena undertook a field visit from Connaught Place to the airport area and emphasised on the "need for coordination" among different government agencies and urban local bodies for upgrading of city infrastructure and beautification of the city, the statement said.

Saxena was accompanied by the Delhi chief secretary, New Delhi Municipal Council chairman, DDA vice chairman, commissioner of MCD and other senior officials of various departments.

ments.

The LG laid special emphasis on horticultural overhaul of the entire stretch by "planting suitable all-weather flowering plants and aesthetic landscaping" including with step gardens and water fountains.

He also laid stress on the use of recycled drain water for the purpose of greening dry stretches and complete collection and disposal of garbage to ensure sanitation and cleanliness.

Saxena on Thursday also paid tribute to Mahatma Gandhi.

"Paid homage to Bapu at #Rajghat after taking oath as Lt. Governor of Delhi. The Mahatma's ideals will always guide my thoughts and actions as I proceed further in discharging my duties and fulfilling my responsibilities," the Delhi LG tweeted.

State-run sports facilities in Delhi to stay open till 10 pm: Kejriwal

All state-run sports facilities in the national capital have been directed to stay open for sportspersons till 10 pm, Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal said on Thursday.

The direction comes after a media report claimed that the Thyagraj Stadium was being closed for sports activities earlier than usual so that Delhi's Principal Secretary (Revenue) Sanjeev Khirwar could walk

his dog at the facility.

"It has come to my notice that sportspersons are facing problems because of the heat and the stadiums get closed by 6 or 7 pm. We are issuing instructions that all sports facilities should remain open till 10 pm so that sportspersons can use them," Kejriwal told reporters here.

When contacted, Khirwar said he is abroad and cannot talk at the moment.

Delhi woman plots her own kidnapping to extort money from brother, arrested

A 38-year-old woman was arrested for allegedly plotting her own kidnapping to extort money from her brother, police said on Thursday.

The police said the woman was going through a financial crisis and was in need of money following which she converted her voice to sound like a man with the help of an app and sent it to her brother for ransom.

According to the police, a complainant was received at the Mehrauli police station on Wednesday in which the man said his sister had been kidnapped and he was receiving extortion calls and messages from her phone number.

He also informed that kidnappers had also sent him a photo of his sister which showed her gagged and her hands tied, police said.

During investigation, the police visited the house of the complainant and checked the CCTV footage of the area where they found that the woman had left her home on Tuesday, a senior police officer said.

The mobile phone of the victim was found switched off and it was only available on WhatsApp through which the 'alleged kidnappers' were communicating, the officer said. Through technical analysis, the location of the phone was traced to Agra.

A police team went to Agra and based on the last location, they searched around 50 hotels and resorts. While checking a hotel in Tajganj Market in Agra, they found the woman, Additional Deputy Commissioner of Police (south) M Harsha Vardhan said.

The woman told the police that she was going through financial crisis and to fulfil her need for money, she herself planned her kidnapping and demanded ransom from her brother in lieu of her release, he said.

She tied her hand with a rope and gagged herself. She also converted her voice into male voice with the help of an app and sent it to her brother for ransom, Vardhan said, adding that the woman was brought to Delhi and arrested under relevant sections of law for extortion.

Will work as 'local guardian': Vinai Kumar Saxena

Vinai Kumar Saxena took oath as the 22nd Lt Governor of Delhi at a ceremony here on Thursday and said he would work as the city's "local guardian" and will be seen more on the roads and less at Raj Niwas.

Saxena (64), was administered the oath of office and secrecy by Acting Chief Justice of the Delhi High Court Vipin Sanghi at Raj Niwas.

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and his Cabinet colleagues, Union minister Giriraj Singh and Meenakshi Lekhi, Delhi MPs and MLAs, and top bureaucrats of the city government attended the ceremony.

"I want to tell each citizen of Delhi that I will work in the capacity of a local guardian rather than as LG. You will see me less in Raj Niwas and more on the roads," Saxena said addressing mediapersons after taking oath of office.

Citing water, air and noise pollution as "inherent" problems of Delhi, the new LG said it would be solved by working together with the Government of India, the

Delhi government and local people. Saxena also said it was his dream that Delhi becomes the "city of joy" as well as the "city of flowers", saying he will work together in this direction. Kejriwal said his government would work together with the new L-G as it had done with his predecessor Anil Bajaj.

"I assure to extend him full cooperation of the government. We will do a lot of good work together with Saxena Saheb as we did with Anil Bajaj," the chief minister told reporters.

Saxena, who was the chairperson of Khadi and Village Industries Commission (KVIC), was appointed the Lt Governor of Delhi on May 23. His predecessor Anil Bajaj resigned as LG on May 18 citing "personal reasons".

Saxena also thanked the President of India, prime minister and the home minister for being entrusted with the responsibility of the post of L-G.

He said during his tenure, efforts will be made to empower the workers of the unorganised sector in Delhi

through training and by providing them equipments.

The new LG also appealed to the people for maintaining communal harmony, citing recent riots and disturbances in the city.

The oath ceremony scheduled to begin at 11 AM was delayed by around 40 minutes. Chandni Chowk MP and former Union minister left the ceremony, expressing unhappiness over seating arrangement for the dignitaries.

The MP said in a tweet that he was asked by an officer to vacate the seat, stating that it was reserved. After waiting for 15 minutes, he left the venue when no seat was given to him.

Saxena is a Kanpur University alumnus with a pilot license.

In March 2021, he was appointed by the Union government as a member of the national committee to commemorate 75 years of India's independence.

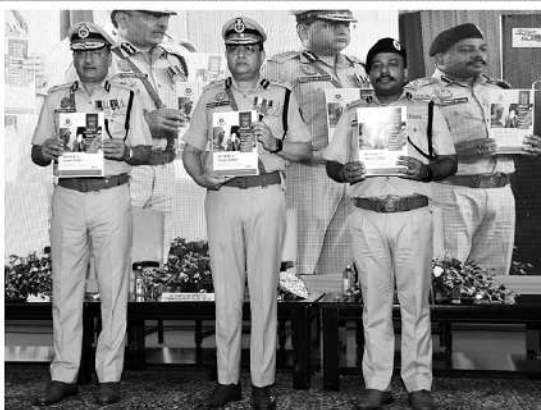
In November 2020, he was nominated as a member of the Padma Awards selection panel for 2021.

Wife, lover, a third held for killing husband in Daryaganj

A 40-year-old woman was arrested along with her "lover" and another man allegedly for killing her husband in central Delhi's Daryaganj area, police said on Thursday.

The accused have been identified as Zeeba Qureshi, a resident of Daryaganj, Shoaib, 29, a resident of Meerut in UP, and Vinay Goswami, 29, a resident of Ghaziabad in UP, they said. Zeeba wanted to get rid of her husband, Moineuddin Qureshi, police said. Qureshi, 47, was shot dead in Daryaganj on May 17 around 10 pm when he was urinating outside gate number 3 of Khalsa School, police said.

During investigation, police drew a conjecture on the basis of the white motorcycle used in the murder that the shooters may have belonged to UP. The motorcycle was found abandoned near Tara Hotel, Daryaganj, and was found to have been stolen from Meerut upon verification, a senior police officer said. Later, with more proof in hand, police nabbed the three accused, including the wife of the victim, Deputy Commissioner of Police (central) Shweta Chauhan said. Zeeba has two sons and a daughter.

Delhi Police lodges FIR day after MP Navneet Rana alleges she received threatening calls

The Delhi Police has registered an FIR a day after Independent Lok Sabha MP Navneet Rana, who was recently granted bail by a Mumbai court in connection with Matoshree-Hanuman Chalisa case, filed a complaint alleging that she received multiple life threatening calls, officials said on Thursday.

Deputy Commissioner of Police (New Delhi) Amrutha Guguloth said the FIR has been registered at

the North Avenue police station under sections 506 (punishment for criminal intimidation) and 509 (word, gesture or act intended to insult the modesty of a woman) of the Indian Penal Code.

Rana had filed the complaint with the Delhi Police on Wednesday. According to the complaint filed by her personal assistant, the MP received 11 calls on Tuesday from 5.27 pm to 5.47 pm on her personal mobile number.

The person on the other

end spoke to her in a very inappropriate way, abused her and also threatened that if she comes to Maharashtra, she will be killed, the complaint said.

The caller threatened the Amravati MP that "if you recite Hanuman Chalisa again, you will be killed," the complaint stated.

The complaint further said that Rana was traumatised.

In April, Navneet Rana and her MLA husband Ravi Rana had announced that they would recite Hanu-

man Chalisa outside Matoshree, the private residence of Maharashtra Chief Minister and Shiv Sena president Uddhav Thackeray in Mumbai.

On April 23, they were arrested by the Mumbai Police on charges of sedition and promoting enmity among communities for their insistence on chanting the Hanuman Chalisa outside Matoshree.

On May 4, the two lawmakers were granted bail by a Mumbai court in the case.
