Delhi logs 54 new COVID-19 cases, two deaths

New Delhi

Delhi recorded 54 fresh COVID-19 cases on Friday with a positivity rate of 1.22 per cent, and two more persons died due to the viral disease, according to a data shared by the health department here.

With these new cases, Delhi's COVID-19 tally has risen to 20,06,443, while the death toll due to the infection rose to 26,511.

Delhi recorded zero death and 65 COVID-19 cases on Thursday with a positivity rate of 1.29 per cent.

The national capital had recorded 58 Covid cases on Wednesday with a positivity rate of 1.03 per cent.

The city had reported 63 cases of the infection with a positivity rate of 1.18 per cent on Tuesday.

The fresh cases came out of the 4,432 tests conducted the previous day.

The number of active cases stands at 293 while the number of patients in home isolation is 214. Of the 8,773 Covid beds in the city hospitals, only 45 are occupied.

Noida Police constable found dead at official residence

Noida

A 32-year-old police constable was found dead inside his official accommodation in Gautam Buddh Nagar district of Uttar Pradesh on Friday, officials said.

Deputy Commissioner of Police (Central Noida) Ram Badan Singh said the constable was found hanging inside his house at the police lines in Surajpur in the morning and it appeared that he took the extreme step due to domestic conflicts.

"Arun Kumar lived in the government-allotted quarter along with his wife, who is also a police constable. Both were of the 2011 batch," Singh said.

The deceased personnel was a native of Saharanpur district and posted as the constable in-charge of the police store in Noida, according to officials.

Police Commissioner Alok Singh, Additional CP Bharti Singh, among other senior officers, on Friday afternoon visited the family to offer condolence at the constable's passing away.

The body was sent for post-mortem and the cause of death has been identified as hanging, officials said, adding that no complaint has been registered in the matter. Mental health experts believe that suicides are preventable if first observers, like parents or spouse or friends, recognise the behavioural changes in a person and talk to them in order to not let them doubt their self-esteem.

Director General (Prisons) Sandeep Goel has been transferred from Tihar Jail, nearly a month after jailed conman Sukesh Chandrashekhar alleged extortion of Rs 12 crore for protection in the prison.

IPS officer Sanjay Beniwal from the 1989 batch has now been appointed as the new Director General (Prisons) of the Tihar Jail in Delhi.

Kumar, after visiting the Anand Vihar smog tower, as part of Delhi Congress' campaign "Pollution On, Kejriwal Gone", said that even experts are in the dark about the utility of the smog tower, which was setup at a cost of over Rs 15 crore, with an annual maintenance cost of Rs 3 lakh.

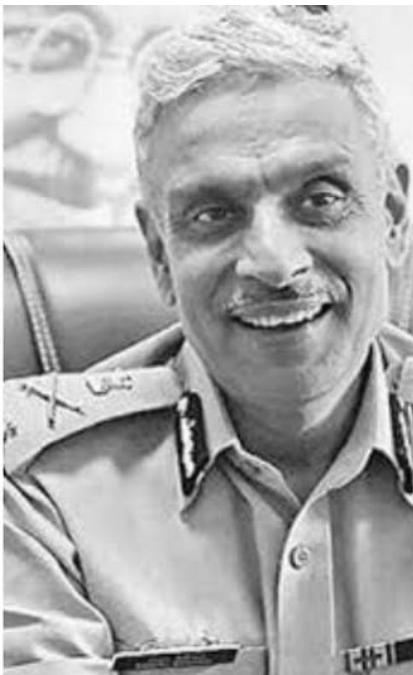

Upgrade STP with modern technology, complete work on time: Sisodia to DJB

New Delhi

Delhi Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia on Friday directed the officials of Delhi Jal Board (DJB) to upgrade the sewage treatment plant with modern technology and complete the work within stipulated time frames, an official statement said.

The DJB has been instructed to take strict action against any lapse by the Sewage Treatment Plant's (STP) contractors in the work to fulfil targets, it said. A work report shall be submitted every day to the deputy CM by the CEO of the DJB as well. It will also be ensured that all stipulated safety standards and measures of quality are followed during this process, the statement further stated.

According to the statement, Sisodia said, "Delhi Government is working in a phased



manner to increase the capacity of various sewage treatment plants in different areas in the national capital to clean the Yamuna."

"The set target is to clean the Yamuna river completely by 2025. As part of this initiative, the 45 MDG sewage treatment plant at Kondli will be upgraded to release clean water into the Yamuna," he said.

In a letter to Delhi's Lieutenant Governor Vinai Kumar Saxena on October 7, Chandrashekhar had made a series of allegations against the Aam Aadmi Party. He had claimed to have paid Rs 10 crore to party leader Satyendar Jain as protection money in jail.

He had also alleged that he paid Rs 50 crore to the Aam Aadmi Party to secure an important position in the outfit. Chandrashekhar claimed that he was promised a post in South India and a Rajya Sabha seat by the Aam Aadmi Party.

Chandrashekhar was arrested by the Delhi Police on August 7 for allegedly extorting around Rs

215 crore from Shivinder Singh, a former promoter of pharmaceutical giant Ranbaxy, and his wife Aditi Singh. He had allegedly impersonated the Union home secretary, law secretary and an officer in the prime minister's office while speaking to them.

In his letter, Chandrashekhar had claimed that Jain visited him multiple times in jail and asked him if he disclosed to the police his contributions to the Aam Aadmi Party.

Jain has been in prison since he was arrested by the Enforcement Directorate on May 30 in a money laundering case.

Chandrashekhar had written to the Delhi Lt Governor alleging that AAP leader Satyendar Jain 'extorted' Rs 10 crore from him in 2019 to ensure his safety in prison.

'sludge treatment plant' at Kondli, during which he found that the sewage treatment has not been following stipulated norms and quality control measures.

He reprimanded the officials and instructed them to resolve this issue at the earliest, for which a plan of action must be submitted to him within a week, the statement said. Sisodia also inspected the sludge treatment plant built inside the premises of the Kondli STP.

He said this sludge treatment plant can treat 200 tonnes of sludge daily. It is based on the technology of hot air oxidation, in which the silt is dried and converted into bio-char using hot air. It is then removed from the sewage, is processed and the residue is used to make tiles, it said.

Will win MCD polls 4th in a row: BJP

The BJP leaders expressed confidence to win the MCD polls 4th time in a row, as the dates for the elections to 250 municipal wards were announced by the state election commission on Friday.

The voting for Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) will be held on December 4 and votes will be counted on December 7.

Inaugurating the BJP's MCD poll office at party's Delhi unit headquarters at Pant Marg, Union minister Piyush Goyal said the Kejriwal government has failed on all fronts including pollution control, reining in corruption or infrastructure development.

"Delhi people are fed up with false assurances of Kejriwal government and ready to give a befitting reply to the AAP in the MCD polls and ensure massive victory of the BJP. They have also made up their mind to vote for the BJP in coming Lok Sabha polls and uproot the AAP in next Assembly elections," Goyal said.

Delhi BJP president Adesh Gupta also claimed that the BJP is going to return to power at Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) for the 4th time.

Welcoming the poll date announcement by the State Election Commission, Gupta said "the kind of public support we are getting, one thing is certain that this time we are going to win more seats than last time." The convener of MCD poll manifesto committee of BJP, Satish Upadhyay launched a portal, inviting Delhiites to give their suggestions on the issues they wanted to be highlighted in the party's poll promises.

Gupta said that the BJP was ready to defeat its opponents like it did on previous occasions.
