Multi-storey parking for 400 vehicles ready

Noida

Multi-storey parking for 400 vehicles is ready in C block of sector-15. This parking will be given to Delhi Metro Rail Corporation. MoU is being prepared for the agreement.

For this there will be a meeting soon at the ACEO level. The official concerned said that documents related to parking construction such as parking design, DPR, fire safety, electrical engineering NOC etc. have been given. The DMRC will be responsible for operation and maintenance after the parking is handed over to it.

Along with this, the parking on the service lane under the sector-15 metro station will be removed. With the commencement of parking, there will be reduction in jam in sector-15 Naya Bans, sector-1 Gol Chakkar and nearby places.

Now after the completion of the construction of multi-storey vehicle parking, the Noida Authority has taken over this parking.

Land acquisition process expedited

In the Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (YEIDA) area, a lot of big projects are going on. So land acquisition process for projects has been expedited.

Land is needed for Film City in sector-21, data centre in sector-28 and other projects. The Yamuna Authority is buying land on the basis of consent from the farmers.

In this process, the land is bought quickly and the farmers get compensation soon. It has made adequate budget arrangements for the purchase of land in its budget.

In the current financial year, the authority will spend more than Rs 3200 crore in land purchase. Out of this, a loan of Rs 1500 crore will be taken.

The officials concerned said that there will be no shortage of funds in land purchase. With the acquisition of land, work on big projects of the authority will be done faster.

Trader robbed of over Rs 10 lakh in Delhi's Seelampur

New Delhi

A 20-year-old trader was allegedly robbed of more than Rs 10 lakh at gunpoint outside his house in north-east Delhi's Seelampur area in the early hours of Thursday, police said.

On Thursday at 1.10 am, two suspects robbed a bag containing Rs 10,80,000 cash at gunpoint from Uruz, a resident of New Seelampur, they said.

Uruz has a metal sheet-cutting business and he was on his way to hand over the money to his driver for further delivery to another party. The incident occurred just outside his house in New Seelampur, police said.

A case has been registered at the Seelampur police station and efforts are being made to identify the accused.

A 23-year-old man was arrested for allegedly making obscene gestures at a woman at Mandi House metro station here, police said on Thursday. The accused has been identified as Shivam Sharma. He has done B.Pharm and was presently working in a marketing department of a pharmaceutical company, they said.

Very dangerous situation: Kejriwal slams PM Modi on bill on appointment of CEC, ECs

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Thursday attacked Prime Minister Narendra Modi on a bill that seeks to replace the Chief Justice of India with a cabinet minister in the panel for selection of the chief election commissioner and election commissioners, claiming it will influence the fairness of elections.

According to the bill introduced in the Rajya Sabha, future chief election commissioners and election commissioners will be selected by a three-member panel headed by the Prime Minister and comprising the leader of opposition in the Lok Sabha and a cabinet minister.

The bill comes months after the Supreme Court in March ruled that a three-



member panel, headed by the Prime Minister and comprising the leader of the opposition in Lok Sabha and the Chief Justice of India, will select the CEC and ECs

till a law is framed by Parliament on the appointment of these commissioners.

In a couple of posts on X (formerly Twitter), Kejriwal also accused Modi of not

following the Supreme Court order and said this is a "very dangerous situation".

"I had already said that the prime minister does not obey the Supreme Court of

the country. His message is clear - he will bring a law through the Parliament to overturn whichever Supreme Court order he does not like. It is a very dangerous situation if the prime minister does not follow the Supreme Court," Kejriwal said.

"The Supreme Court had formed an impartial committee which will select impartial election commissioners. The prime minister by overturning the Supreme Court has formed a committee that will be under his control and he could make a person of his liking election commissioner through it. It will influence impartiality of elections," he said and alleged that "the prime minister is weakening Indian democracy through decision after decision".

In another post, he wrote

the committee proposed for selection of election commissioners will have "two BJP and one Congress members". "Obviously the selected election commissioner will be loyal to the BJP," the AAP convener said.

AAP national spokesperson Saurabh Bharadwaj alleged that the Centre is "once again" overriding the Supreme Court's decision after the Delhi services bill.

"After passing the Delhi services bill by going against the Supreme Court, the Centre is now trying to override another court order by introducing the bill on appointment of election commissioners. It is unfortunate that the institutions (ED, CBI, EC) that used to be viewed with utmost respect, are now facing allegations of siding with the Centre," Bharadwaj said.

Company Director arrested by EoW for fraudulently defaults Rs 2.5 Cr. bank loans

Economic offences Wing (EoW) of Delhi police has arrested a proclaimed offender involved in multi-mortgaging various properties with multiple banks through obtaining Rs 2.5 Crores loans, said the police on Thursday.

The arrested man has been identified as Hitesh Kumar. Earlier he was engaged in multiple small businesses. He became a partner and director in a company with Anurag Sharma, they said.

According to police, a complainant Jocku P Joseph who is Sr. Manager in the Federal Bank Ltd., Nehru Place Branch, Delhi. He has alleged that Successpath Marketing Pvt Ltd and its Directors Anurag Sharma and Hitesh Kumar had availed credit facilities/loan of amount Rs. 2.5 crore from complainant bank for business purpose.

"The loan documents and agreement were executed between bank and borrowers. The loan amount was secured through mortgage of

property Plot at Village- Ziauddinpur, Balbir Nagar Extension, Shahdara, Delhi as well as with residential flat at Village- Sikdarpur, 60th Ft Road, Shahdara, Delhi. Later alleged persons defaulted on the repayment of monthly installments and their account became NPA," the official said.

"Thereafter bank initiated proceedings under SARFAESI ACT for possession of the property, it came to their knowledge that Dena Bank had also initiated measures under SARFAESI ACT for the same property which was mortgaged with them. Dincur Bajaj also revealed that said property is also mortgaged with India Bull.

DCP, EoW Surendra Chowdhary said that during investigation of the case, it was revealed that details from various banks have proved the mortgage and the loans/CC facility obtained by the accused using forged documents of the properties. The person who purchased the property from the accused has also been examined.

The special staff and the operation cell of Shahdara district police in a separate operation have arrested 23 gamblers for allegedly running a Satta racket inside the premises of two houses, said Delhi police on Thursday.

Police have seized many gambling accessories and Rs 21,790 and Rs 27,760 cash from their possession, they said.

DCP Shahdara district Rohit Meena said that our special staff team and operation cell were tasked to detect and prevent organized crime incidents that have increased in the Shahdara district of Delhi. "The first operation took place on August, 07 in Shahdara District where in a secret information received that one person namely Sachhe is running illegal Satta at H.No. A-350, Gali No.6, NSA Colony Delhi in Farsh Bazar police station," DCP Rohit Meena said.

"Immediately, a raiding



team led by inspector Vikas Kumar under supervision of ACP Operation Gurudev Singh conducted a raid and apprehended 16 persons including four hired Munshi and 12 punters while playing Satta. A stake money of Rs. 21,760 recovered from the spot," DCP Rohit Meena mentioned.

The official said that Suchha was organiser of this Satta however he was

not present at the time of raid. He had hired four Munshi for Rs 500 each per day to monitor the illegal gambling.

However in the second operation, a raid was conducted on the basis of a secret information at a house E-131, Dilshad Garden in the area of Seemapuri, Delhi and apprehended eight persons involved in gambling, they said.

Beisde cash, the police have seized Satta Parchis, Dairies, pen, Red & white colour Wooden Charkhi and White colour Numbering chart, Playing Cards, Writes Slips, 28 Blanks Slips, 2 Balls Pen to be used for Satta Writing

Further investigating is underway and efforts are being made to arrest of the organizer of the Satta racket, the official said.

Burglar evading arrest in 9 house burglary cases since 2021 arrested

A house burglar who was on long run in nine cases of house burglary has been arrested by a team of Central Range unit of Delhi police Crime Branch, said the police on Thursday.

The accused was identified as Raja Ram Sah (34), a resident of J.J. Colony Bhalswa Dairy, Delhi. He was a proclaimed offender in dacoit case in PS Jahangirpuri. The accused was also involved in nine burglary cases registered at different police stations in Jaipur, Rajasthan, the police official said.

On 23 July, 2021, two boys had entered carrying a knife and a screwdriver in a house of a woman when she was present alone at her house at C-Block, Jahangir Puri, Del-



hi. Duo accused had robbed 300 grams gold, 500 grams silver, and cash of about 2 to 2.5 lakhs from his house. The accused Raja Ram Sah was evading his arrest since 2021.

Special CP (Crime) Ravindra Singh Yadav said that the

investigation of the case was continued. In the meantime, the police received a specific information regarding the presence of an accused involved in the above case in a Jhuggi Samalkha Camp, Kapashera, Delhi. Subsequently, a trap was laid un-

der the supervision of ACP Pankaj Arora and the accused Raja Ram Sah was apprehended from

"During interrogation, the accused Raja Ram Sah disclosed that as he is a Sunar by caste, he has good knowledge of jewellery making. To earn easy money, he indulged in crime and was not only involved in the commission of crimes but also in disposal of the looted jewellery articles. After the registration of a case of dacoity in PS Jahangir Puri, he fled away from Delhi and hide himself in the adjoining states," the official mentioned.

The accused further revealed that meanwhile, he along with his associates, committed a number of burglaries in the area of Jaipur, Rajasthan.

Haryana govt responsible for Delhi floods: Bharadwaj

New Delhi

Delhi minister Saurabh Bharadwaj on Thursday said the Haryana government's action against its irrigation department officials is a "clear admission of its responsibility" for the unprecedented floods in the capital in July.

Addressing a press conference, he requested the neighbouring state to hand over the management of the ITO Barrage to the city government. A downpour on July 8 and 9 in Delhi and subsequent heavy rain in the river's upper catchment areas, including Himachal Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Haryana, had led to the Yamuna swelling to record levels last month. The river breached embankments and penetrated deep into the city, causing massive damage to public and private property. The Delhi government had alleged that some of the gates of the ITO barrage got jammed due to silt accumulation, hindering the quick drainage of river water.

Following a probe into the matter, the Haryana government on Wednesday suspended an irrigation department chief engineer and chargesheeted three other officials.

"The chief engineer concerned sits in Delhi. His primary work is to ensure prop-

er functioning of the barrage. He and his subordinates failed to fulfil their responsibility. "Earlier, Haryana had even refused to acknowledge that the barrage belongs to them and that they are responsible for its maintenance. They have now admitted their mistake and taken action against the erring officials," Bharadwaj said.

Guards soon to be deployed in all MCD-run schools: Mayor

Guards will soon be deployed in all MCD-run schools to ensure safety and security of children, Delhi Mayor Shelly Oberoi said on Thursday.

She held a meeting with teachers' organisations at the Civic Centre here. During the meeting the mayor listened to the various problems and demands of teachers.

For ensuring safety and security of students studying in the Municipal Corporation of Delhi-run schools, "guards will soon be appointed in all the schools," she was quoted as saying in a statement issued by the MCD.

The mayor said data entry operators will also be appointed in all schools, to "free teachers from non-academic work".

Oberoi assured teachers that a portal for transfer of teachers will be opened soon.
