Convicted prisoner dies in hospital

Noida

A convicted prisoner lodged in Laksar jail died in the hospital on Wednesday morning. The prisoner was serving sentence for raping a teenage girl. He is said to be suffering from cancer.

The prisoner was shifted from Muzaffarnagar jail to Laksar jail last year. According to the police, 31-year-old Parvez, a resident of Mohalla Khadar Wala in Muzaffarnagar district, was lodged in Laksar jail. A case was registered against Parvez four years ago in Kotwali Nagar, Muzaffarnagar, for raping a teenage girl and under the POCSO Act.

Muzaffarnagar court had sentenced Parvez to twenty years of imprisonment in the case of raping a teenage girl. On September 17, 2023, Parvez was transferred from Muzaffarnagar to Gautam Buddha Nagar jail. He was suffering from cancer for a long time. He was undergoing treatment at Safdarjung Hospital in Delhi.

On Wednesday morning, Parvez had trouble in breathing. He was admitted to the Government Institute of Medical Sciences in Kansa for treatment where he died during treatment.

Sector Eeotche-1 police station in charge Anuj Kumar said that the body has been taken into custody and sent for post-mortem. The matter is being investigated by the police.

Rahul Gandhi to address public meeting for Kanhaiya today

Delhi Congress chairman of the communications department Anil Bhardwaj here on Wednesday informed that Rahul Gandhi will address a public meeting for North East Delhi Lok Sabha candidate of Congress party for I.N.D.I.A Alliance Kanhaiya Kumar on Thursday, May 23, 2024.

The public meeting would be organised at DDA Ground, GTB Enclave, Dilshad Garden. Bhardwaj further said that Rahul Gandhi will also address a 'town hall' for the Congress candidate for North West Delhi Lok Sabha candidate Dr Udit Raj on Mahila Vihar (Maha Lakshmi Nyay Yojna) at Patti Tent House, near petrol pump, Industrial area, Phase-1, Mangolpuri tomorrow, Thursday, May 23, 2024.

Bhardwaj said that the BJP deceived those living in unauthorised colonies with ownership rights and those in slum dwellers with in-situ flats to relocate them from their slum clusters and the BJP has totally sidelined these issues in its Lok Sabha election manifesto.

He said that the Congress party had begun the process of regularising unauthorised colonies, but the Modi government halted the process, indulging in charges and counter charges. He said that out of the eight lakh residents registered for ownership rights in unauthorised colonies, only around 25,000 people have so far got conversion deeds.

BJP plans to create water crisis in Delhi, says Atishi

Delhi Cabinet Minister Atishi on Wednesday alleged that the Haryana government has "stopped" the water supply to the national capital under a "new conspiracy" hatched by the BJP to target the Aam Aadmi Party ahead of voting on May 25 in the national capital.

Haryana Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini, however, rejected the allegation, saying the water supply to Delhi "is continuing as per the agreement and nobody can stop it".

The Delhi Jal Board (DJB), which is responsible for water supply in the national capital, also issued a statement saying the water level of Yamuna River at Wazirabad on a daily basis in May was far better than the levels measured in May of 2021 and 2022.

"Particularly, the data from 15th May (in 2024) onwards revealed that on each day, the water level at Wazirabad was higher as compared to the levels recorded in the years 2021 and 2022 for each corresponding day," DJB said.

Further, the total production capacity of DJB from all sources including Water Treatment Plants (WTPs) and tube wells is 956 Million Gallons per Day (MGD) against which the production from May 1, 2024, to May 21, 2024 ranges between 1003 MGD to 981 MGD, it said.

The daily production of water is more than the installed capacity of 956 MGD (both WTPs and Tube wells), the Delhi government



agency said.

"DJB assures the people of Delhi that focused attention is given continuously for the optimum production and supply of water to the people of Delhi. DJB is fully geared up to meet the demand and handle any unforeseen situation in the ongoing summer season, 2024," it said.

The water level in the Yamuna River at Wazirabad depends upon many factors like weather conditions, temperature, state of precipitation in the catchment area, and regeneration of the river among others.

"These fluctuations are routine and standard in nature, particularly become significant in summer months," the DJB said.

Hitting out at the Atishi, Delhi BJP president Virendra Sachdeva said AAP has come out with a "new lie" as it fears defeat in the polls and alleged that it was corruption and inaction of the AAP government that is responsible for the shortage of water in Delhi.

Atishi, who holds the water portfolio, wrote a letter to Haryana Chief Minister Saini over the matter.

Addressing a press conference earlier in the day, she

said the BJP has been hatching conspiracies to target AAP ever since the Lok Sabha polls were announced.

"Within five days of the announcement of Lok Sabha polls, Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal made it clear on Wednesday that his wife Sunita is not likely to contest elections in the future, saying she has no interest in active politics even though she came out aggressively in public after his arrest."

Kejriwal spoke at length on a variety of subjects, including the "humiliation" he suffered during his incarceration, accusations against him, what his family is going through and the prospects of the opposition INDIA bloc in the 2024 Lok Sabha elections.

"In every stage of my life, Sunita has supported me. I am fortunate to have a partner like her. To tolerate an eccentric person like me is not easy," Kejriwal said.

He recalled that in 2000 he took leave from his job as an income tax commissioner to work in Delhi's slums, and then resigned to devote himself full time to the social work.

"At that time I had no inkling that I would become a chief minister or set up a party, contest elections. I was just driven and worked for 10 years. Even then she supported me. Think what she must have gone through then!" he said.

It is clear that Haryana is not releasing Delhi's water share of Yamuna water, she said, adding this reduction in water levels of the Yamuna is having a serious impact on water production for the people of Delhi.

"It almost seems to be a deliberate conspiracy amid the election season, aimed at creating an artificial emergency, thereby disrupting the normalcy of life in Delhi and creating a situation of panic," she said in the letter.

This issue of reduction in Yamuna water levels in Delhi has been brought to the attention of the Irrigation Department of the Haryana Government multiple times by the officers of the Delhi Jal Board, she claimed.

"Despite repeated requests to release sufficient water to maintain the minimum pond level of 674.50 feet at Wazirabad Barrage, there has been no improvement in the situation."

"In light of the urgent need to provide adequate water supply to the residents of Delhi, I earnestly request your immediate intervention in this matter. It is imperative that the State of Haryana must immediately release Delhi's rightful share of water into the Yamuna River to bring the waters to the normal level of 674.5 feet," she added.

Sachdeva, however, sought to corner Atishi, asking what steps she had taken to improve the water supply situation in the past month after Kejriwal had issued instructions to her on the matter from jail.

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Sunita not keen on politics, won't fight polls: Kejriwal

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Kejriwal was arrested on

March 21 in connection with a money laundering case and alleged irregularities linked to the Delhi government's liquor excise policy from 2021 to 2022. He was released on interim bail on May 10 to campaign for his Aam Aadmi Party in the ongoing general elections.

Soon after he was arrested, Sunita Kejriwal, also a former income tax officer, took the political centre stage of the party. She read out Kejriwal's message from jail, conducted road shows and gave speeches at opposition rallies.

Asked if she will continue her political role, Kejriwal replied, "When I was arrested, she was a bridge between me and Delhi's residents. It was a temporary phase. She has no interest in active politics. In future also, it is not like she will contest elections."

On whether Sunita Kejriwal will continue his work once he is back in jail, the chief minister answered, "We will approach court to be provided facilities in jail so that I can continue my work as chief minister of Delhi."

Kejriwal described his wife as a brave and strong woman, adding his two children are also becoming strong and brave.

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BJP's "Abki Bar, 400 Paar" campaign a complete fantasy: Tharoor

Member of Parliament and CWC member Dr Shashi Tharoor, addressing a press conference in support of three Congress candidates from Delhi for the Lok Sabha elections, here on Wednesday said that people were looking for change, saying BJP's "Abki Bar, 400 Paar" campaign is a complete fantasy.

Tharoor said that in 2019 due to the tragedy at Pulwama, the Lok Sabha election, which should have been a referendum on the economic failures of the BJP in its first term, turned out to be a conversion national security, but the results of the 2019 elections are impossible to replicate for the BJP this time, due to changing trends.

"We are doing significantly better than last time in places like Rajasthan, Haryana, Madhya Pradesh, Chattisgarh and even in Uttar Pradesh. On top of that, in Bihar, Bengal and even a couple of places in



Gujarat, it is not going to be easy for the BJP, and our Atma Vishwas (self confidence) has gone up", Tharoor elaborated.

He said that the main purpose of this Lok Sabha election was to change the government in Delhi. Tharoor said that going into the last two weeks of this election, it has become apparent that people are disillusioned with the Modi government for the undelivered promises in the past ten years, and in every constituency, national and local issues were being highlighted by the Congress party and "we are looking forward to very good results".

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MCD begins preparations for mosquito control ahead of monsoon

The MCD has begun its preparations to prevent mosquito breeding across its zones with increased inspections of houses, fogging activities, and special drives at hotspots where large-scale breeding of mosquito are reported, senior officials said.

The Municipal Corporation of Delhi, however, refused to provide a report on the dengue figures in the Capital. The MCD stopped publicly releasing weekly data on vector-borne diseases on August 7 last year in the run-up to the G20 Summit.

The officials said that several anti-larval measures have been started to prevent transmission of vector-borne diseases like Dengue, Malaria and Chikungunya ahead of the monsoon.

The shower season in Delhi starts around the end of June or the first week of July.

To target the breeding at the source, the corporation has used "larva-eating fish" called Gambusia affinis extensively at 216 biological control points (fish ponds)



across its 12 zones.

"The advantage of Gambusia fish is that they feed on larvae of mosquitoes. The cost of introducing larvivorous fish is relatively lower than that of chemical control and it is an environment-friendly method. They can be introduced in shallow water where mosquito larvae breed like ponds," a civic body official explained.

The Public Health Department of the corporation plans to open more such fish ponds in the jurisdiction of the MCD with the onset of the monsoon.

However, when asked about the dengue cases in the city, an official said "The data is not available to us".

As per the data accessed, the MCD has conducted more than 1.29 crore house inspections to date this year

with action taken against 24,480 houses where domestic breeding of mosquitoes in open contaminated water was found. The corporation sprayed insecticides at 1,84,035 houses for the prevention of adult mosquitoes.

Furthermore, MCD claims to conduct special drives to cover vulnerable spots like construction sites, police stations, parks and nurseries, health institutions, schools and other educational institutions, and government offices, among others.

A fine of Rs 5,18,605 has been collected by the MCD from action taken against 2,899 offenders under the Malaria Bye-Laws of the DMC Act. A total of 25,055 legal notices and 5,766 challans have been issued by the corporation to date.

"All known hotspot colonies are being checked and anti-mosquito measures are taken intensively. Public awareness by meeting with RWAs, Nodal Teachers, Market Associations School and Staff Rallies are also being organised from time to time."

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Massive crowd gathers at PM's rally as Delhi sizzles at 43.4 deg C

Donning saffron clothes, a massive crowd from across Delhi and neighbouring areas braved the summer heat to gather at the BJP's poll rally site in Dwarka here on Wednesday well in advance to listen to Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

Ankush Kumar, a resident of Gurgaon in Haryana where polling would be held in the sixth phase on May 25 along with Delhi, said that he reached the rally site, close to Sector 13 Dwarka Metro Station, around 2 pm.

"I came here just to see the prime minister," he said.

The national capital on Wednesday recorded a maximum temperature of 43.4



degrees Celsius, three notches above the season's average, and remained in the 'Yellow' alert zone.

Chants of "Modi, Modi" and "Jai Shree Ram" rent the air while many, including women, danced to drum beats as the prime minister reached the state around

6.15 pm. They waved their mobiles with flashlights while chanting "Modi ji ko Jai Shree Ram" and "Abki baar 400 paar" to greet Modi.

"Not only from Delhi, people have arrived from different parts of the country to listen to PM Modi's

speech," said Krishna Devi, who reached the rally site from Shahdara.

Another person at the rally, Karan Singh, said, "We want a 'Majboot (strong) sarkar', not a 'majboot (helpless) sarkar'. We are witnessing development across the country, look at the expressways. A huge gathering like this is always expected at the PM's address irrespective of the weather."

Karuna Singh, a Delhi resident, mentioned the consecration ceremony at the Ram Temple in Ayodhya, the 2016 surgical strike and the abrogation of Article 370 in 2019 to say, "We are lucky to have witnessed such moments."
