Noida Pushes export hub ambitions

Noida (UP): A meeting chaired by District Magistrate Medha Roopam on Monday discussed measures to strengthen Gautam Buddh Nagar's position as a major export hub, with exporters raising concerns related to foreign trade procedures, customs clearances and tax refunds.

The meeting, held at the Collectorate auditorium, was attended by exporters, industry representatives and officials from various departments.

Deputy Director General of Foreign Trade Hemant Kumar made a presentation on the Directorate General of Foreign Trade's (DGFT) initiatives, export promotion schemes and efforts to simplify procedures. He said Gautam Buddh Nagar is among Uttar Pradesh's leading export districts and contributes significantly to the state's overall exports.

During the discussion, exporters highlighted delays in amendment and closure of Advance Authorisation and Export Promotion Capital Goods (EPCG) licences, besides technical issues related to updating Importer Exporter Code (IEC) profiles and digital signatures.

Industry representatives also flagged delays in cargo inspections at Inland Container Depots (ICDs), repeated queries in valuation and classification matters, delays in IGST refunds and the need for better coordination between customs officials and exporters.

The district magistrate directed the concerned departments to ensure time-bound resolution of exporters' grievances and work in coordination to further develop the district as a strong export centre.

Man Held with Country-Made Pistol in Noida

Noida (UP): A man allegedly planning to commit theft was arrested with a country-made pistol in Noida's Sector-126 area, police said on Monday.

The accused was identified as Ashish, a native of Motihari district in Bihar, who is currently residing in Bakhtawarpur village on rent.

Police said he was apprehended after receiving information from an informer about a suspicious person conducting reconnaissance in the area.

During questioning, the accused allegedly admitted that he was surveying locations with the intention of carrying out thefts, police said.

Preliminary investigations revealed that he had been involved in theft-related offences in the past. Further inquiry is underway.

YEIDA Opens Industrial, Housing Plot Schemes

Noida (UP): The Yamuna Expressway Industrial Development Authority (YEIDA) has launched new schemes offering industrial and group housing plots in its integrated industrial township, aiming to attract investors ahead of the operationalisation of the Noida International Airport at Jewar.

Officials said registrations for eight industrial plots and two group housing plots will begin on June 25.

The move comes amid rising investor interest in the region, driven by the upcoming airport project and expanding industrial infrastructure.

CM Gupta expands time-bound service delivery System, 23 new citizen & business services added

■ **Move Aims to Boost Ease of Doing Business, Reduce Delays and Strengthen Administrative Accountability Across Delhi**

New Delhi: In a major governance reform aimed at improving public service delivery and enhancing the ease of doing business in the national capital, the Delhi Government has brought 23 additional services under the Delhi Right of Citizen to Time Bound Delivery of Services Act, 2011. Chief Minister Rekha Gupta on Monday said the decision would benefit both citizens and businesses by ensuring that key approvals, licences, registrations and No Objection Certificates (NOCs) are delivered within prescribed timelines.

Describing the initiative as a significant step towards transparency, accountability

ty and good governance, the Chief Minister said the objective is to minimise delays, reduce repeated visits to government offices and cre-

ate a more efficient administrative system. She noted that the reform would particularly benefit sectors such as industry, trade, hospital-

ity, tourism, construction and services.

Gupta said the Delhi Government is committed to creating a business-friendly environment that encourages investment, entrepreneurship and job creation. She added that the initiative aligns with Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of Ease of Doing Business and reflects the government's focus on delivering citizen-centric governance through time-bound services.

Under the expanded framework, factory plan approvals by the Labour Department will now be granted within 15 days, while registration under the Shops and Establishments Act will be completed within a single day. Sewerage connections

from the Delhi Jal Board and film shooting permissions from the Delhi Tourism and Transportation Development Corporation will be issued within 15 days. Applications related to electricity meters and connection agreements will be processed within 60 days.

Several municipal and regulatory services have also been brought under the time-bound system. These include permissions for mobile tower installations, hotel registrations, amusement park operations, water sports activities and food business NOCs. Registration of weighing and measuring instruments, battery waste management authorisations and various agricultural licences related to

pesticides and seeds will also be processed within defined timelines.

The Chief Minister further announced that permissions for tree felling under the Delhi Preservation of Trees Act, road-cutting approvals by the Public Works Department and registrations of builders and real estate agents under RERA will now be delivered within specified periods, ensuring greater predictability for businesses and developers.

Calling the reform a step towards empowering citizens, Gupta said the system would strengthen public rights while making government departments more accountable for service delivery. She emphas-

sized that the ultimate goal is to establish an efficient governance framework where citizens and entrepreneurs receive services on time, transparency is maintained and development projects move forward without unnecessary delays.

■ **Delhi Govt Says CAG Audit Will Ensure Transparency and Protect Consumers from Alleged ₹38,000-Crore Burden**

New Delhi: Delhi Power Minister Ashish Sood on Monday welcomed the Delhi High Court's decision permitting a Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) audit of private electricity distribution companies (discoms), describing the ruling as a major step towards transparency and accountability in the power sector. The minister alleged that the judgment has exposed what he termed a long-standing nexus between the previous Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) government and power distribution companies.

Addressing the media, Sood accused the former government led by Arvind Kejriwal of failing to pursue a CAG audit despite having the authority to do so. He claimed that the previous administration had relied on an interpretation of a 2015 court ruling to avoid conducting an audit of discom accounts and alleged that



this enabled a lack of financial scrutiny in the sector.

According to the minister, resistance by power distribution companies to the proposed audit raised serious questions about financial transparency. He argued that the Delhi High Court's observations had clarified that there was no legal restriction preventing a CAG audit and said the verdict had effectively removed doubts surrounding the issue.

Sood further alleged that consumers in Delhi had been burdened with regulatory assets amounting to nearly

₹38,000 crore under the previous administration. He questioned the justification for such liabilities and stated that the Delhi Government would ensure that citizens are protected from any additional financial burden arising from decisions taken in the past.

The minister also informed that the process for conducting the audit is moving forward and that the Lieutenant Governor's office has initiated hearings with the concerned power companies. He noted that electricity distribution firms

have been given an opportunity to present their views as part of the statutory process before further action is taken.

Reaffirming the government's commitment to consumer welfare, Sood said the Delhi Government would pursue the highest standards of transparency and accountability in the power sector. He maintained that any irregularities uncovered during the audit process would be examined thoroughly and that appropriate action would be taken in accordance with the law.

The minister assured residents that the government's priority remains protecting consumer interests while ensuring a transparent and accountable electricity distribution system.

He said the CAG audit would help establish greater public confidence in the sector and ensure that all stakeholders remain answerable for their decisions and actions.

Delhi Accelerates Aravalli Restoration, Plans Plantation of 10 Lakh Native Trees in Southern Ridge

New Delhi: The Delhi Government has intensified its eco-restoration and wildlife conservation efforts at the Asola Bhatti Wildlife Sanctuary, with plans to plant over 10 lakh native trees across the Southern Ridge as part of a major initiative to revive the Aravalli ecosystem and strengthen the capital's ecological resilience.

The Department of Forests and Wildlife is implementing a scientific restoration programme aimed at transforming degraded landscapes and former mining areas into self-sustaining forest ecosystems. The project focuses on native and ridge-specific species through carefully planned plantation, monitoring and maintenance practices.

Environment, Forest and Wildlife Minister Manjinder Singh Sirsa said the Asola Bhatti Wildlife Sanctuary is among Delhi's most valuable ecological assets and plays a critical role in preserving the Aravalli ecosystem. He said the government's objective is not merely to increase tree cover but to restore degraded land into thriving habitats that support biodiversity, improve air quality and strengthen environmental sustainability.

To support wildlife during periods of water scarcity, especially in summer, the sanctuary has developed 218 strategically located water-



holes along wildlife corridors. These water sources are regularly replenished to ensure uninterrupted access to drinking water for animals and birds.

Recent camera-trap records and field observations have documented the presence of the Indian leopard, the sanctuary's flagship species, along with striped hyenas, spotted deer, porcupines, reptiles and numerous bird species. Conservation activities, bird-watching trails and habitat management programmes

are also being expanded across Delhi's Ridge forests.

Bharat Nursery, located within the sanctuary, is currently nurturing nearly six lakh saplings of native species that will support afforestation projects, habitat restoration efforts, urban greening programmes and free distribution to citizens.

During a recent visit to the sanctuary, Chief Minister Rekha Gupta praised the ongoing conservation work and announced the launch of the "Clean Delhi, Green Delhi" campaign in July. The ini-

CM Gupta Hands Over ₹10 Lakh Ex-Gratia to Families of Saidulajab, Hauz Rani Tragedy Victims

New Delhi: Delhi Chief Minister Rekha Gupta on Monday handed over ex-gratia assistance of ₹10 lakh each to the families of those who lost their lives in the Saidulajab building collapse and the Hauz Rani fire tragedy. The assistance was distributed during a meeting with the bereaved families at the Delhi Secretariat.

Expressing deep condolences, the Chief Minister said that no financial aid could compensate for the loss of a loved one, but assured the families that the Delhi Government stood firmly with them in their hour of grief. "Those responsible will not be spared under any circumstances," she said, adding that the government is taking concrete steps to prevent similar incidents in the future.

The Saidulajab building collapse on May 30 claimed several lives, while the June 3 fire in Hauz Rani, Malviya Nagar, resulted in the loss of multiple members of the same family. Describing the tragedies as a loss not only for the affected families but for society as a whole, the Chief Minister emphasized the need for accountability and stronger safety mechanisms.

During the meeting, family members shared



their concerns regarding emergency response systems and administrative arrangements. Many were visibly emotional as they recounted their experiences and urged authorities to implement effective preventive measures.

Responding to these concerns, the Chief Minister said the government views the incidents as lessons that must strengthen public safety. She announced that a special fire safety plan is being prepared to tackle the increasing number of fire incidents in the capital. The initiative includes enhancing the capacity of Delhi Fire Services and procuring smaller fire-fighting vehicles capable of accessing narrow lanes and densely populated areas more quickly during emergencies.

MLA Satish Upadhyay and senior government officials were also present at the meeting.
